

# Elements of a Short Story

## KEY

Title and Author

**Title:** What the story is called/the name of the story

**Author:** Who wrote the story

Setting

**Where and when the story takes place**

- **Broad:** world, country, general environment, past, present, future
- **Specific:** town, building, exact location, decade, year, day

Characters

**Who the story is about**

The people (or animals or objects that are human-like or "alive")

Plot

**What happens in the story**

The journey the characters take (literally or figuratively)

Beginning, Middle, End

Conflict

**The problem that must be solved**

- **External:** person/person, person/nature, person/technology, an enemy, a character is lost, looking for something
- **Internal:** person/self, fear, the character doesn't want to do something, lack of confidence

Point of View (POV)

**Who is telling the story**

First-person: I, me, my

Third-person: He, she, they, it

- **Third-person Omniscient:** knows everything
- **Third person Limited:** knows only the POV of the main character in the scene (a single point of view)

Themes

**What the story is about**

A lesson to be learned

Examples: Love, loyalty, friendship, getting along, doing what's right even when it's hard
